The PSETA has a vacancy for an ICT Steering Committee Chairperson with Information Technology expertise and therefore would like to invite a suitably qualified person to serve on this Committee.

PURPOSE OF THE ICT STEERING COMMITTEE:

The ICT Steering Committee is an integral element of the ICT governance within PSETA. The committee functions in an advisory capacity to ICT Management and reports to the Audit Committee in terms of:

- ICT governance (compliance with the DPSA Corporate Governance of ICT framework as well as strategic alignment, value management, risk management, resource management and performance management);
- ICT compliance including ICT policies, procedures and standards;
- ICT projects;
- ICT control environment including the resolution of audit findings; and
- Cyber security.



REQUIREMENTS:

Competency Requirements:

- Extensive expertise in ICT governance, strategy and implementation;
- Expertise in ICT investment, and monitoring the management and mitigation of ICT risks;
- Knowledge of the DPSA Corporate Governance of ICT framework, COBIT, ITIL and ISO standards;
- Cyber Security Knowledge.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Post graduate degree in Information Technology or Computer Science.
- Industry related certifications such as the following will be an added advantage: CGEIT, CISA, CISM, CISSP, COBIT and/or TOGAF.
- Proven knowledge and experience in a SETA Environment, Government Departments, State-Owned Entities' (SOEs') operational environments and accountability structures; IT industry legislation, policy frameworks and best practices; IT governance principles and processes; IT architecture principles; development of IT frameworks, policies and processes; IT risk management; ITIL processes; and implementation of IT strategies and plans.
- Applicants must have a minimum of 8 years' working experience in an IT role at Senior Management level and preferably currently a Chairperson or member of an ICT Steering Committee.

The remuneration shall be in line with the Accounting Authority approved remuneration policy aligned to National Treasury remuneration directives.
